Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc.) is a three years Degree Program spread over Six Semesters. This program is approved and sanctioned under University Grants Commissions guidelines for providing Skill Based Education under National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF). It is "Multi Entry- Multi Exit" program which facilities Students to exist from any Level as per his/her desire.

1. Skill Education Component (60% Weightage).

2. General Education Component (40% Weightage)

This component is decided by Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati.

On completion of the each level of B.Voc. degree program following skills will be generated among the students.

Professional Knowledge is what a learner should know and understand with reference to the subject.

Professional Skills are what a learner should be able to do and, **Core skills** refer to basic skills involving dexterity and use of methods, materials, tools and instruments used to perform the job including IT skills needed for that job.

Responsibility aspect determines the **(i)** nature of working relationship **(ii)** level of responsibility for self and others **(iii)** managing change and **(iv)** accountability for actions.

Admission Criteria:

Category 1: Student already acquired NSQF certification Level 4 in a particular industry sector and opted admission in the skill based course under NSQF in the institutions recognized under Community Colleges/ B.Voc. Degree programme/ Deen Dayal Upadhaya KAUSHAL Kendras in same trade with job role for which he/she was previously certified at school level.

Category 2: Students who have acquired NSQF certification Level 4 but may like to change their trade and may like to change their trade and may enter into skill based courses in a different trade.

Category 3: Students passed 10+2 examination with conventional schooling without any background of vocational training with physics as compulsory subject at HSSC examination.

Beside above students of Category 3 has to qualify in Entrance Test to be conducted in the month of May/June Every Year.

Separate Notice will be issued for giving details of Entrance Test.

Fee Structure: Details of fees shall be made available in the college prospectus.

Assessment: 1. Assessment of Skill Education Component of each course will be done by certified assessors appointed by Health Care Sector Skill Council, New Delhi.

2. Assessment of General Education Component shall be done by Sant Gadge Amravati University, Amravati as per University Rules & Regulation.
